Martinborough vineyard '22 Sauvignon Blanc Martinborough	\$13.5	\$72
Beautiful subtropical aromas of passion fruit and snow peas. Creamy mid palate. Deliciously smooth style of Sauvignon Blanc.		
Peregrine '23 Chardonnay Central Otago	\$17	\$94
Juicy, powerful Chardonnay. Lots of stone fruit, especially apricot. Good citrus acidity and a rich, fruity finish with great length.		
Quartz Reef '22 Pinot Gris Central Otago	\$16	\$89
Attractive, fragrant, youthful wine with organic and biodynamic certifications. Rich, lively pear, lychee and spice flavours fill the mouth, showing great finesse and power, with a delicately poised, dry finish.		
René Muré Orchidées Sauvages '18 Gewürztraminer Alsace	\$15	\$78
Soft nose with fresh aromas of lychee, underlying apple, rosewater and pickled ginger. Off-dry and medium-bodied. Balanced acidity brings freshness and a clean finish.		
Poppies '23 Rose Martinborough	\$18	\$108
This is simply delicious, aromas and flavours of fresh red cherry with a lick of maraschino, strawberry and chilled red fruits tea. Crisp, dry, A wine perfect on its own or with fresh fare from tuna sashimi or Tataki.

Johner Estate '22 Pinot Noir Wairarapa	\$13.5	\$72
Rich, ripe and juicy fruit on the nose, with fresh red berry and cranberry flavours on the palate. Mouth-filling, silky tannins and a long finish. A good value for money Pinot Noir.		
Blank canvas Settlement '19 Pinot Noir Marlborough	\$23	\$126
This Settlement Vineyard Pinot Noir is a typical expression of Omaka with great density and intensity. Ripe blue and red fruit flavours seamlessly give way to an attractive savoury edge and sappy aromatic spice.		
Mollydooker The Boxer '21 Shiraz McLaren Vale, AU	\$17	\$94
Boxer Shiraz is a surprisingly rich and powerful red wine. This full-bodied Shiraz boasts a rich, velvety texture, highlighted by a powerful, persistent finish, all underpinned by a bold, balanced tannin structure.		
Unison Rocky Red '21 Cabernet, Merlot Hawke's Bay	\$13.5	\$72
Intense flavours of classic plum and dark berries overlay the fruit with oak, nutmeg spice, chocolate and subtle dried herbs. Creamy texture and mouth-coating tannins. Juicy, concentrated finish with energy and great length.

Cloudy Bay TE KOKO '19 | Sauvignon Blanc | Marlborough \$180

Subtle and complex. The nose is nuanced, with citrus, stone fruits and savoury notes of soft woodsmoke. Mellow oak and mineral characters are balanced by the vibrant acidity and freshness of citrus and conference pear. A long and elegant finish draws together this dense and powerful wine.

ATA RANGI Masters '20 | Chardonnay | Martinborough \$192

Seamless, pure, very elegant, varietal and complex bouquet. Aromas and flavours of mineral and apple, white peach and citrus, raw cashew nut and a mix of sweet barrel spice with a gentle smoky quality. Fantastic texture as the wine touches the palate, very seductive and layered. Flavours mirror the bouquet, salivating acid line with a lick of saline.

KUSUDA '23 | Riesling(dry) | Martinborough \$118

Originally from Japan, Hiro Kusuda is known for his rigorous attention to detail and commitment to quality. Impressive purity and power with an ethereal texture. White flowers, lime zest, and glycerol together with an impressive sweet/sour balance that leaves a lingering, refreshing finish.

Red

Pegasus Bay Prima Donna '16 | Pinot Noir | Waipara \$212

Pegasus Bay's Flagship Pinot Noir in a typically rich and generous style made using 30% whole-bunches during fermentation. Dense, silken-textured wine, with a mellow savouriness and flavours suggesting ripe plum, vanilla, chocolate, coffee, spice and anise. A complex and appealing red.

KUSUDA '20 | Pinot Noir | Martinborough \$250

An unwavering devotion to quality and precision defines Kusuda's winemaking philosophy, particularly evident in his Pinot Noir, which has earned widespread acclaim as one of the finest expressions of Martinborough's terroir. A fine, almost ethereal pinot noir with floral, red rose, violet, red cherry, redcurrant, and oyster-shell flavours.

ATA RANGI Célèbre '21 | Syrah, Merlot, Cabernet | Martinborough \$128

Perfect conditions for ripening Syrah and Merlot, with a little Malbec and Cabernet Franc to boot. Abundant in flavour, succulent and lengthy, this tastes celebratory.

KUSUDA '18 | Syrah | Martinborough \$220

Pale garnet. So black-peppery on the nose. Light and sleek – really smooth and ethereal. Great, delicate balance between fruit and acidity.

Kusuda is known for attention to detail, to the point that each berry is picked individually at harvest. Naturally this precision comes at a cost, in particular the miniscule volumes produced, and as such stocks are extremely limited.
